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Purpose

This policy aims to regulate the scope, standards and competencies for the practice of Registered Nurse (RN) /midwife and advanced nursing/midwifery practice in Jordan.

Policy

1. JNC develop framework for RN, standards and competencies which is the foundation for nursing curricula and job description.
2. JNC develop framework for scope of practice, standards and competencies for advanced nursing practice.
3. JNC Revising standards for practice of RN and advance nurse practice every three years

Required forms/equipment

Procedure

1. The standards and competencies develop by:
 - 1.1 consulting nurse specialists
 - 1.2 reviewing feedback provided by specialty nurses in a variety of health practice settings
 - 1.3 consulting nurse's faculty members from different academic nursing schools.
 - 1.4 review the best possible evidence of international models and framework
 - 1.5 Review job description in health practice settings

For RN/midwife

- a) Define RN /midwife (Legal &professional),
- b) Determine Scope of practice, Professional standards, practice standards and competencies.

For nurse specialist and advanced nurse specialist

- a) Define advance practice nurses in different specialties
 - b) Develop standards and competencies for each specialty based on RN national frame work
2. The standards and competencies review and edit by experts in each specialty
 3. The standards and competencies approve by JNC board
 4. The standards and competencies issue and publish in booklets
 5. The standards and competencies booklets disseminate to health and academic institutions
